



Phases:

- Honeymoon: excitement, happy feeling, ready to tackle obstacles
- Negotiation/ Culture Shock: stress, unhappy feelings, having to deal with problems and differences
- Adaptation: getting used to other culture, good orientation
- Mastery: adaptation to other culture, habits, mastering differences
- Reverse Culture Shock: after coming back to home country!!!

How to manage your culture shock, subtle it and enjoy your stay as much as possible Also some tips how to take care about your mental health

How to Survive Other Culture(s)

- Tolerate
 - Do not judge differences and different approach
- Do not try to reshape the others
 - It is a waste of energy, you are the foreigner there
- Don't be ashamed
 - When making things differently
- Ask and discuss
 - Why others do and see things differently
- Use technique of "seven breath"
